Wisconsin Chapter
Carroll Norden Memorial Scholarship

The Wisconsin Chapter of the American Fisheries Society established a “Statewide Scholarship” in 2004. It was renamed the Carroll Norden Memorial Scholarship in 2007. The purpose of the scholarship was to provide financial support to fisheries students attending a Wisconsin university other than UW-Stevens Point. The scholarship is awarded on an annual basis in the amount of \$1,000.

Requirements and Limitations: Each applicant must: (1) be a student member of the Wisconsin Chapter; (2) shall be a Junior, Senior or Graduate Student at the time of application; (3) shall major in a Fisheries Science related program; and (4) shall be enrolled in a Wisconsin based university other than UW-Stevens Point.

Application Materials: The following materials comprise a complete application package. One copy of the complete application package must be received by the Wisconsin Chapter AFS Scholarship Committee on or before **December 15**.

Failure to meet the deadline or to follow instructions invalidates the application.

- 1) A completed application form (located on the web site).
- 2) A one-page resume of the applicant emphasizing fisheries related courses.
- 3) A statement of professional goals, accomplishments, and involvement in fisheries related activities.
- 4) A supporting statement (letter of recommendation) by a university advisor or past employer

Evaluation Procedures: The following criteria will be evaluated in ranking applicants:

- 1) Completeness and timeliness of the application package;
- 2) Professional goals and accomplishments;
- 3) Involvement in fisheries science, either volunteer or employment; and
- 4) Recommendation of a fisheries-related scientist.
